Role models have been shown to be related to the achievements of young people in many career-related outcomes. Students who have four or more role model encounters are **five times more likely to be in further education**, **employment or training** when they leave school, yet studies show that **1 in 4 children do not have role models in their lives**. Role Model Week **(10 - 14 October 2022)** is an opportunity to recognise and celebrate the importance role models play in building careers aspirations and drive equality for young people.

During the week we will:

- Inspire primary students through schools holding role model dress up days
- Encourage primary and secondary schools to discuss the importance of role models with their students and hold various education activities including inviting F4S role models to speak in their schools
- Motivate more young girls to consider careers in STEM by celebrating Ada Lovelace Day (11 October) by holding a STEM focused F4S Digital webinar on the day and encouraging schools to book STEM role model encounters through the F4S platform such as our Maths4Girls role model events
- Universally instill the message of how role models can inspire any young person to achieve the future they deserve despite their socio economic background
- Encourage professionals to register as a volunteer on the F4S platform to be real life role models to the next generation
- Raise awareness of F4S, our mission and values through a concentration of volunteer, educator and parent engagement
